



Rejuvenate your pond with a Spring Pond Clean Out!

• <u>SPRING Pond Clean Out</u> Here's what we do—Setup holding Tank, Fill Tank with pond water, gently Transfer Fish to netted & aerated tank, Flush excess Pond water into landscape, Rinse Rocks & gravel and Remove Debris, Clean Filters, filter pads, pumps, skimmers, Replace Bulbs in underwater lights as needed (bulbs extra), Fertilize Pond Plants, Transfer tank Water to pond, Condition Water, gently Transfer Fish back to pond, use your garden hose to begin refilling the pond — Re-filling usually takes a few more hours after we leave, when pond is full you simply plug in the pump ... (Supplies Included as needed: water conditioner, waterfall foam as needed, dose of beneficial bacteria, fertilizer.) Clean Pond and Happy Fish! You can relax and we will call to let you know that your clean out is done and the *fish are smiling*!

•<u>Summer Plan</u> Empty debris net/basket, clean skimmer & filter mats, disconnect pump & clean, check underwater lights & replace bulbs as needed (cost of bulbs extra), trim & remove dead plants, fertilize water lilies, cover liner, foam loose rocks, add bacteria, add additional product as needed.

• A La Carte Service If you plan to do most of the service on your pond, simply give us a call if you need a little extra maintenance or troubleshooting help. (\$129 Service Call)

Our pond technicians will use caution while netting, temporarily housing and acclimating your fish and other pond life. Temporary fish storage will be no less than a 100 gallon tub with aeration and a mesh cover. Fish are transferred with Koi quality nets and are stored in the existing pond water. After slowly matching temperature, we make every reasonable effort to bowl the fish carefully into the cleaned pond. We cannot be held responsible for any scratches, scuffs, cloudy eyes, parasites, re-injuries, ulcerations, or loss of life Because your fish are living creatures, there are many factors beyond our control which may cause death or injury to your fish.
